DICK GOULD, Stanford University's John L. Hinds Director of Tennis, was the Men's Tennis Coach for 38 years (1966-2004). During his amazing career, he coached the team to:

- 17 NCAA Team Championships, 10 NCAA singles champions & 7 NCAA doubles championship teams.

Coach Gould coached:

- 9 players to reach the top 15 in ATP world singles rankings, 15 players who reached top 10 in ATP world doubles rankings, A record 7 who attained a #1 world doubles ranking, 8 former Stanford players reached at least the Round of 32 at Wimbledon 1982, 4 reached at least the Wimbledon Quarterfinals in 1983.
- 2 years at Mountain View High School ('61 & '62) & 4 years at Foothill College (JC) '63-'66 (with 2 state junior college championship teams).

Coach Gould, a pioneer in the collegiate tennis world, is the author of *Tennis Anyone*, now in its 6th edition. Additionally Dick Gould is the husband of Anne Gould, coach of Stanford's first women's national championship in any sport.

“I hope that I've conveyed to my players over the years that there is a way to approach competition and that way can epitomize things like sportsmanship, integrity and class. I hope I have been an example in that respect, not only for my own teams, but for other college teams and other people in sports...” ~ Coach Gould
